International youth football tournaments

Germany » 2021

Munich – home of the german football league's champions!

KOMM MIT's latest summer tournament takes place in the Free State of Bavaria close to Munich – the Munich-Summer-Cup. The fame of Germany's record winning team attracts many young players, both male and female, from Germany and especially from abroad. Experience with your team a few exciting football days with a mix of tradition and modern spirit. Make your stay perfect with a visit of the Allianz-Arena and build international football friendships.



The tournament is organised by SV Lohhof, the municipality of Unterschleissheim and KOMM MIT.



Games are played in the Hans-Bayer-Stadium as well as on modern grass and artificial turf pitches in Unterschleissheim and the surroundings. Changing rooms and showers are available.



Teams will be accommodated in the tented camp at the sports grounds (team tents, bookable from min. 18 to max. 22 persons per tent). Adequate sanitary facilities are provided on site: please bring your own air mattress/camping mat and sleeping bag. Additional accommodations are located in Unterschleissheim and surroundings (youth hostel, pensions and hotels available upon request).



Teams who have booked the tent camp can expect half board (breakfast/dinner): the meals are served in a catering tent directly at the sports grounds. In the hotels and other accommodations breakfast is included and additional meals can be booked. Furthermore, the host club will arrange catering tents at the sports grounds.



A swimming pool close to the sports grounds offers refreshment after exhausting matches. The stadium of FC Bayern Munich, the Allianz-Arena, as well as the FC Bayern „Erlebnisswelt“, the club's museum, are just a few steps from the accommodations and definitely worth a visit. Explore the capital city of Munich by yourself or book a guided tour. Don't forget to visit the nearby Memorial place of the concentration camp Dachau, monument of Germany's darkest chapter in history. Some excursions need to be booked already six weeks before the tournament.
